

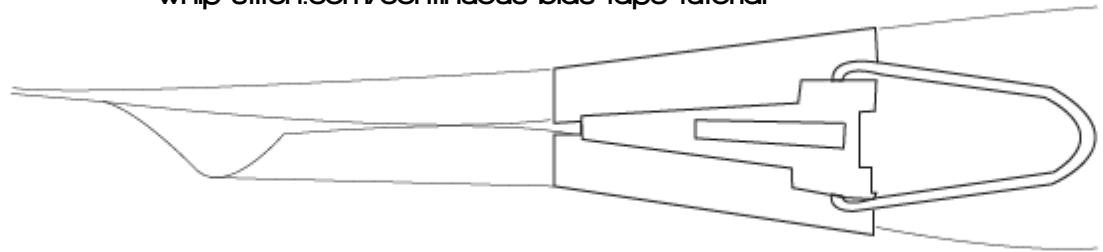

Continuous Bias Tape

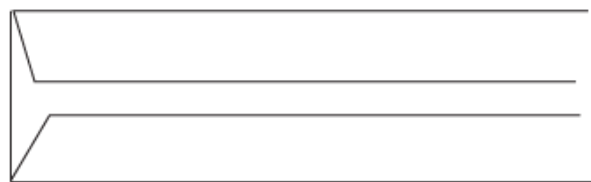
Continuous Bias Tape is made by stitching a tube of pre-marked fabric and making a single, un-ending length of bias strips all at one go by sewing a single seam. It's an amazing time-saver and a fun technique to master to expand your sewing repertoire! Full instructions are available on my blog and in video format on YouTube.

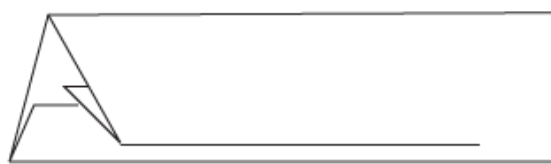


bias tape maker size	finished width		Clover brand tape maker color	cut strips to the following width	
	single fold	double fold			
6mm or 1/4"	1/4"	1/8"	green	3/8"	9.5mm
12mm or 1/2"	1/2"	1/4"	yellow	7/8"	22mm
18mm or 3/4"	3/4"	3/8"	red	1 3/8"	35mm
25mm or 1"	1"	1/2"	blue	1 7/8"	47.5mm
50mm or 2"	2"	1"	black	3 7/8"	98.5mm

Any of these can be rounded up to the next whole inch/mm
